- From 2016 to 2021, jobs increased by 2.0% in Poinsett County, AR from 6,694 to 6,829. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 1.8% by 0.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 53.2% to 53.8% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.7% of Poinsett County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (11.6% below the national average), and **4.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity






Job Trends




Poinsett County, AR had a May 2022 unemployment rate of 3.22%, decreasing from 4.19% 5 years before.










Top Industry Location Quotient








Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Location Quotient


Top Occupation Earnings



Median Hourly Earnings


